Instructions for Applying to Kinesiology – Exercise and Movement Science Program

DEADLINE: February 15, 2021

Applying to the Kinesiology – Exercise and Movement Science program is as simple as completing an online application. This may be done at any point during the application period, ideally as soon as the applicant makes the decision to apply for admission to the Kinesiology – Exercise and Movement Science program.

Admission to the Kinesiology – Exercise and Movement Science program can be limited and competitive. Obtaining or exceeding the minimum eligibility criteria does not guarantee admission. Applicants should carefully review the program admission information available HERE.

Part One: Required Documents

Completing the Online Application

The online application for the Kinesiology–Exercise and Movement Science program may be accessed via the School's <u>Apply to a Program page</u> and must be completed by February 15, 2021. The online application consists of the following parts and has required documents listed below:

Transcripts¹

Current and prospective UW-Madison students must upload their unofficial transcripts from each college or university they are currently or have previously attended². Transcripts must be a single PDF per school or college.

Personal Statements

Students must submit a response for each prompt below. Please upload a single PDF document with both your responses.

- Part 1: In 250 words or less, express your motivations for choosing Kinesiology as a major and how it relates to your future goals.
- Part 2: In 500 words or less, reflect on how your background and experiences pertain to your future success as a Kinesiology student and ultimately, your future goals.

Student Biographical Questionnaire

Students must upload a completed Student Biographical Questionnaire Form to this application. Click <u>HERE</u> to download the form. The completed document should be saved and uploaded in PDF format.

A space for this response will be provided in the online application. (Maximum 250 words)

Part Two: Letter(s) of Recommendation Letters of Recommendation can be submitted before completion of application.

Thoughtful letters from teachers or employers addressing the student's interest and experience are beneficial to the selection process. Recommendation letters should provide information about a student's intellect, imagination, or diligence that is not evident in other parts of the application.

- Students should be sure to follow up with their recommenders to confirm their letters are submitted
- <u>At least one</u> letter must be received before February 15, 2021, in order for the application to be considered eligible
- A maximum of two (2) letters will be accepted per applicant.

Applicants can direct their recommenders <u>HERE</u> to upload their letter of support. Recommenders should provide the following:

- Student's Name (First & Last)
- Student's Email Address (Optional) Providing this information will send a receipt email to the applicant confirming submission of letter
- Recommender's Name (First & Last)
- Recommender's Email
- Letter of Recommendation in PDF form
